Rules

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2017 – 2020 *Racing Rules of Sailing*.

Entries and Eligibility

All yachts entering the Regatta must hold a current FYCA handicap.

Separate starts are expected to be offered for yachts with provisional handicap splits for Division 1 Yachts <975, Division 2 Yachts 975 and above, and Restricted Sail (Restricted yachts are not permitted to fly spinnakers, cruising chutes or twin headsails, but may pole out headsails). Boat handicaps are those published currently by the FYCA for 2017. The Race Committee reserves the right to change division splits and merge classes or starts should this prove necessary. FYCA Safety Regulations Cat 4R shall apply. Full details of Cat 4R Regulations can be found at <http://www.fyca.org.uk/Data/fycasafetyregsiss3.pdf>

Registration

All boats **must register** on Saturday 24th of June at Forth Cruising Club between 11:00 & 12:20 BST or via FCC club boat Osprey, which can be hailed via the Starters hut, Call Sign 'Forth Cruising Club' on VHF Ch.M1 between 12.20 and 13:00 BST

Fees

The entry fee is £10 per boat, cheques payable to Forth Cruising Club. Entries must be received by Thursday 22nd of June. If entering by email the appropriate fee must be paid prior to the close of registration. We would prefer the entry fee to be paid in advance but in exceptional circumstances payment may be accepted 'on the water'.

Race Area

The main race area is the arena between the Forth Road Bridge to the east and Kincardine Bridge to the west, giving due regard to any restrictions imposed via current Notices to Mariners

Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions and courses will be published at least seven days before the event and will be made available on the FCC & FYCA websites.

It is recommended that competing boats be familiar with these before the event.



Schedule

Two races are scheduled for Division one yachts in this Regatta, first start scheduled for 13.20 BST.

One race is scheduled for Division two yachts in this Regatta, start scheduled for 13.25 BST.

One race is scheduled for Restricted Sail yachts in this Regatta, start scheduled for 13.30 BST.

Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk. See Part 1 Fundamental Rules, Racing Rules of Sailing. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the Regatta.

A boat is entirely responsible for her own safety whether afloat or ashore. Nothing, whether in the Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility. It is for the boat to decide whether she is fit to sail in the conditions in which she will find herself. By going to sea, the boat confirms that she is fit for those conditions and her crew is competent to sail and compete in them.

Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the boat nor will it make the Organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the race and the event, and include the organising authority, the race committee, and the race officer.

Insurance

Each participating yacht shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000.

Berthing

Free of charge drying moorings will be available overnight on Friday 23rd, Saturday 24th and Sunday the 25th of June.

The Club house will be open to visiting crews on the Friday evening.

Prize giving will take place on Saturday in the Clubhouse as soon as practicable after completion of racing.

The club boat "Osprey" will be available, after the end of the days racing to ferry crews from yachts anchored outside Brucehaven harbour to/from the Clubhouse.
